Patchy light freezing drizzle possible overnight

UPDATE POSTED 5:30 P.M. SUNDAY: The National Weather Service reports patchy light freezing drizzle could occur into tonight, resulting in areas of icing, especially on bridges and overpasses.

The Danville Police Department today responded to one single-vehicle crash. A vehicle slid into a tree due to the wet conditions, causing minor damage and no injuries.

Power utility crews continue their work to restore power outages. They are being assisted by four crews from High Point, N.C., which arrived early this afternoon. We have about 300 outages scattered in several areas of Pittsylvania County, and also Henry and Halifax counties.

Three feeder circuits have gone offline during the day. Feeder circuits serve several hundred customers. These circuits served portions of Mount Hermon, Blairs, Laurel Grove and Dry Fork. All three circuits are back in service.

Few outages have occurred today within Danville city limits.
